

Tango is a leading mobile messaging service with more than 400 million registered members around the world. In 2014, Audio Visual Design Group was contracted to provide the audio visual systems within their new offices in Mountain View which underwent an extensive tenant improvement. The project consisted of two floors of presentation and collaboration spaces including an All Hand Café space, boardrooms, several conference rooms, war rooms, and extensive displays throughout the open office area used to display critical analytics.

Tango has a lot of custom, real time analytics they use to measure various metrics throughout their office space. There is a tremendous amount of data there that needs to be easily pulled up and viewed anywhere, at any time. Utilizing SVSi encoders, Crestron automation and flat panel displays, AVDG was able to create a custom display solution throughout the space that enabled users to instantly pull up multiple streams that live on Tango's virtual machines on any display. This same system also allows the user to call up content from a local laptop utilizing portable encoders that just require an HDMI connection and even programs like the World Cup from the cable boxes that live in the centralized rack.
